



POSITION: Water Resources Engineer or Water Resources Specialist

REQUIREMENTS:

- BS or MS degree in civil, environmental, or agricultural engineering or degree with similar technical coursework, preferably relating to water resources and/or irrigated agriculture.
- Efficiently manage and operate Excel spreadsheets, including both models and databases.
- Manage water resource-related research projects, including project development, quality assurance, scheduling, budgeting, and effective communication with landowners.
- Preparation of technical reports, graphics and presentations.
- Ability to write grant applications, including scopes of work, budgets, and project schedules.
- Review of studies, reports, and other technical documents.
- Self-motivated and strong time management and organizational skills.

- Ability to travel independently with occasional overnight stays.
